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New consent form for Aadhaar seeding

Reference is drawn to our following circulars:

- a) Circular no 251 dated October 26, 2017
- b) Circular no 264 dated December 20, 2017
- c) Circular no 265 dated December 26, 2017

UIDAI vide their Gazette notification no 13012/79/2017/Legal-UIDAI/(No. 6 of 2017) dated December 19, 2017 has mandated few changes in the Aadhaar seeding process to ensure informed consent of the customer.

Indian Banks' Association (IBA) vide their circular number PS & BT/Govt./4317 dated January 12, 2018 has advised banks to seek consent of the customers in the new format prescribed there in (enclosed).

We have already communicated the changes in the file format for Aadhaar seeding INPCI mapper with effect from January 01, 2018 vide our circular number 265 (enclosed).

Banks should take immediate steps to implement all the necessary changes for implementation to comply with the directive mentioned above and to ensure informed consent of the customer for seeding of Aadhaar in CBS and NPCI mapper. The new consent form prescribed by IBA is appended in the Annexure.

Please note:

As per the new format the customer want to change the subsidy credit to the account he/she, maintained with your bank from another bank then he/she, at the time of requesting the bank for seeding, has to provide the bank name to which his Aadhaar is already mapped in NPCI mapper. The bank should provide the IIN of that bank in the seeding file (as per the new mapper file format specifications) to get the Aadhaar number moved in to them.

So



- 1. The source of getting the bank name to which the Aadhaar is currently mapped should be the customer only. The bank should not use any other means like Aadhaar mapping query, look up facility or data from any government departments, to get the current bank IIN.
- 2. As per the Gazette notification of Government of India (cited above) any violation of the directions shall amount to violation of Sections 37, 40, 41, 42, and 43 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016 and Regulations framed thereunder and other applicable laws of

Member banks should note that

- 1. It is mandatory that all the banks implement the new consent format (Annexure I) both in physical as well as electronic formats used to obtain the customer consent. You may please be guided by NPCI circular no.251 and 265 dated October 26 and December 26 on the modalities to be followed for obtaining customer consent.
- 2. All the banks should submit a compliance report on implementation of the new format and compliance to various circulars as per the enclosed format (Annexure II) before January 31, 2018.
- 3. Submission of compliance is mandatory to have access to Aadhaar mapping process, NPCI may disallow mapping access to the banks that will not submit the combliance with in the timeframe specified. In the event of any bank being disallowed for mapping process then such bank will be allowed only to deactivate the Aadhaar numbers from mapper, they will not be able to do fresh seeding and also move in however the Aadhaar numbers if uploaded by another bank, as per the new format, will be allowed to be moved out to the new bank.
